ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, The National Greyhound Association, the Federation Cynologique Interationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of the Desert-Bred Saluki (SPDBS). Limited/Provisional breed entries must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. Currently, Cirneco Dell'Etnas, Chart Polskis, Galgos Espanol, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Magyar Agars and Portugese Podengos are eligible for entry.

- Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted
- Early-Entries will not be acknowledged by mail; Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail if requested and if an e-mail address is provided
- Early-entry fees submitted and accepted with early-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early-entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for early-entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- Hounds may enter the SINGLES stake without having ASFA certification, but must provide a copy of their official registration papers.
- Hounds entering the SINGLES stake may compete with breed disqualifications**

STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake	Any eligible sighthound one year of age or older on the day of the trial having met ASFA certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record
Field Champion Stake	Any ASFA Field Champion
Veteran Stake	Any eligible hound, having met ASFA certification requirements, whose age exceeds six years except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall exceed five years and Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets whose age shall exceed seven years

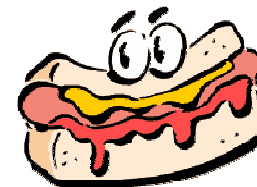

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- Day-of-trial-entry fees submitted and accepted with day-of-trial-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for day-of-trial-entries. Requests must be made in person to the FTS. No refunds for day-of-trial-entry fees will be returned after the closing of day-of-trial-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- Substitutions may be made for hounds lame or in season **at the time of roll call**
- Entries shall be refused for First Time Entered Hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes that do not have a copy of registration papers (NGA Greyhounds excepted) to accompany a completed, signed and approved certification form. If a hound has earned a title that waives the certification requirement, a copy of that title certificate must accompany the appropriate ASFA form of waiver
- Stakes will be split if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw
- The SPLITTING of FLIGHTS (as applicable) will be performed each trial day at the FTS Desk upon the closing of entries
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified
- Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered
- Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded
- Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment available
- The lure will consist of light and/or dark colored plastic and/or fur.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled
- Certifications will be offered as time allows. A \$8 fee will apply.
- Fun Runs or Practice Runs will be offered on Sunday only and as time, equipment condition and daylight allow. Please sign up at the FTS desk. These runs will begin after the completion of the trial and certification runs (afternoon or late afternoon). Each run, \$5.00.

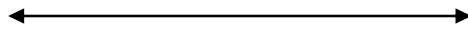

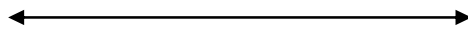
THE ANTICIPATED

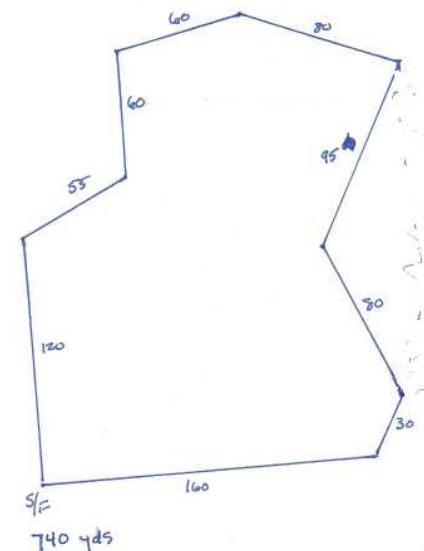
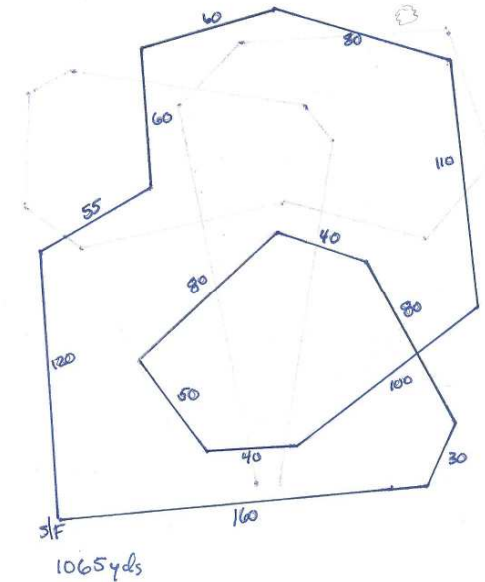

 Best in Field will NOT be offered



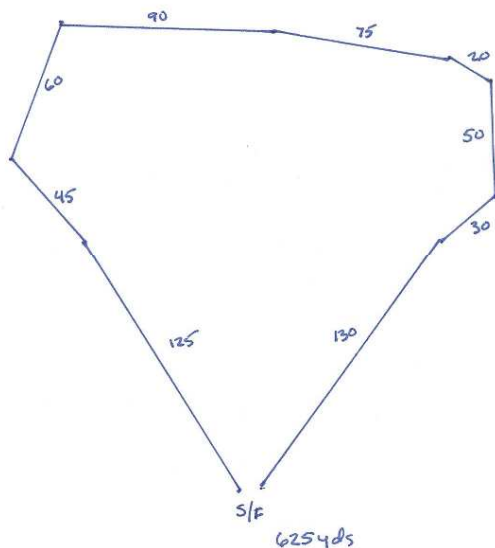
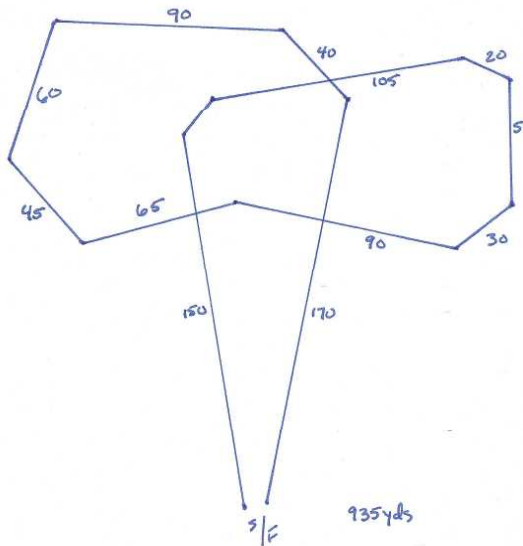
