

CONSTITUTION GAZEHOUNDS IN TEXAS

ARTICLE I

Name and Objects

SECTION 1. The name of the club shall be Gazeounds in Texas.

SECTION 2. The purposes of the club are educational, recreational and social in nature and are defined as follows:

- a) To further the advancement of all sighthound breeds in their historical role as hunters who capture their quarry through the chase; to test sprint speed and function; to evaluate breeding stock; and to encourage the development of well trained racers competing against other sighthounds in organized amateur racing events
- b) To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of amateur sighthound racing and to encourage sportsmanlike competition at such events
- c) To conduct amateur race meets under the auspices of the Large Gazehound Racing Association, the National Oval Track Racing Association and any other organizations offering amateur sighthound racing.

SECTION 3. The club shall not be conducted or operated for profit and no part of any profits or remainder or residue from dues or donations to the club shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual.

SECTION 4. The members of the club shall adopt and may from time to time revise such bylaws as may be required to carry out these objects.
